## **Guideline on Sexual Health Research**

Considering the necessity for conducting research and promoting knowledge generation on sexual health, this guideline serves as a supplementary document for other national regulations and guidelines for medical research, in order to clarify and facilitate research on sexual health.

Similar to any research field, research on sexual health shall comply with approved methodological frameworks and research ethics guidelines, and take the relevant cultural sensitivities into consideration. The results of such research may be published provided that the research is previously approved by the National Committee for Ethics in Biomedical Research.
